

## **JOCK WHITE MEMORIAL FIELD DAY 2005 RESULTS**

Weather conditions were much better for all this year and activity levels were up. The valid multipliers for field stations increased from 80 to 97 and contacts by the top 80M phone station rose from 514 to 556. However, activity on 40 metres was low even when the band was in good shape – it was poor for local working for much of Sunday morning. More activity is needed on 40.

### **Some notable activity:**

ZL1ASO set up as a field station at Bombay using a horse trailer as shelter and giving 00 as Branch number because it was only decided to operate at the last minute. Operated from a battery by father and son Rob ZL1DM (age 78) and Ian ZL1ASO. Teaming up in field day had been talked about for many years.

ZL1DM was operated from outside the Papakura clubrooms by Geoff ZL1AKY assisting two newcomers.

Rod ZL1PY of Te Puke operated QRP from 2000 feet ASL on the shore of Lake Waikaremoana in Wairoa Branch territory, hence the /52 number.

ZL2AS Hastings operated by Warren ZL2AJ in spare time while on an annual AREC exercise in Kaweka Ranges.

ZL2QF Patea won the Patea Shield (donated by the Branch) for the first time. ZL1BCO Taupo displaced frequent winner ZL1IZ Waitomo at top of the phone only section.

### **General:**

Some excellent logs – ZL1IB comes to mind – also some very scruffy logs this year.

Several stations also qualified in sections other than those entered.

No logs received from Branch 05 (several), 18, 29, 80. These had to be reconstituted from other logs to check for validity. Branch 05 was marginal but allowed.

Some home stations used Branch numbers – these were not allowed. Also invalid were Branch 18 (CW), 45, 50 (40M) and some others due to insufficient contacts.

Contacts claimed as multipliers were not marked by many – these must be highlighted in some way.

Check logs were appreciated.
