FMTAG NOTES FOR JULY 2008

NZART Council approved publication of the following FMTAG notes at its July 2008 meeting.

INTERIM RECOMMENDATIONS TO NZART COUNCIL

Published for the information of, and seeking comments from, NZART members.

Branch 46 Wairarapa has applied to change the modulation mode of its 3825 voice repeater, located at Pariwhariki map reference NZ260 T27 389077, to D-Star DV Mode (digital voice and low speed data), having a RF occupied bandwidth of about 6 kHz. An engineering evaluation confirms that there will be no interference to other stations, and that the repeater transmit frequency can remain on 433.825 MHz and the receive frequency can remain on 438.825 MHz. Note that the inverted frequencies are necessary to ensure compatibility with the inverted frequencies of the co-located 495 National System repeater and the inverted National System UHF Link Station (ULS) from Pariwhariki to Belmont.

Branch 63 Upper Hutt has applied for a VHF Link Station (VLS) at its clubrooms, located at map reference NZ260 R27 845070, to link to its 730 repeater at Mt Climie. The link transmit frequency will be 147.900 MHz and the receive frequency will be 147.300 MHz. An engineering evaluation confirms that there will be no interference to other stations.

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS TO NZART COUNCIL

Published, as Interim Recommendations, in May/June 2008 Break-In, for the information of, and seeking comments from, NZART members. No comments have been received.

D-STAR (AND SIMILAR DIGITAL MODES) SIMPLEX (D-Star = Digital Smart Technologies for Amateur Radio) Modify the table at the bottom of Page 4-12 of the 2007-2008 Call Book by adding the following:

144.550 MHz narrow digital mode simplex of up to 16 kHz RF bandwidth. 432.550 MHz narrow digital mode simplex of up to 16 kHz RF bandwidth. 1296.550 MHz narrow digital mode simplex of up to 16 kHz RF bandwidth. F+0.550 narrow digital mode simplex of up to 16 kHz RF bandwidth.

1294.125 MHz wide digital mode simplex of up to 250 kHz RF bandwidth.

D-STAR (AND SIMILAR DIGITAL MODE) REPEATERS

Narrow mode (such as, but not limited to, D-Star DV mode) repeaters can be accommodated within the existing narrowband FM (NBFM) repeater band segments, provided that the particular channels are not shared with NBFM repeaters. The input and output frequencies will usually be site-specific, chosen during engineering compatibility certification, as described in RSM MED publication PIB38 (available on the MED web site).

Wide mode (such as, but not limited to, D-Star DD mode) repeaters (which occupy the equivalent of ten contiguous NBFM repeater channels) can be accommodated in the 23 cm band within the existing repeater segment, provided that the particular channels are not shared with NBFM repeaters. The input and output frequencies will usually be site-specific.

D-STAR (AND SIMILAR DIGITAL MODE) LINKING

Wide mode (such as, but not limited to, D-Star DD mode) linking, and wider bandwidth linking, can be accommodated in the 3 cm band.

It is proposed to modify the 10 GHz bar-graph, part way down the right-hand column of Page 3-3 of the 2007-2008 Call Book, by adding the following:

Linking. 10,000 to 10,050 MHz and 10,400 to 10,450 MHz.
