# **Proposed Changes to 27 MHz Amateur Band**

It has just come to our notice that changes being proposed by the Radio Spectrum Policy and Planning group to the CB licence (see

 $\underline{http://www.rsm.govt.nz/cms/pdf-library/policy-and-planning/current-projects/cb-discussion-paper-gul-2010.pdf)}$ 

will, if approved, give CB radio users access to our 26.95 to 27.3 MHz Amateur Band. (There are also changes planned at UHF but these do not appear to affect Amateurs.)

Submissions on the proposals are due to close tomorrow -11-FEB-2011- but we have agreement from the Ministry that we may put in a late submission.
