FISTS Down Under (FDU) Award

To encourage more on-the-air CW activity and to create an easy goal for new-comers, FISTS Down Under (FDU) is sponsoring the following award for December 2024.

Basic Award

Make at least 10 QSOs within 10 consecutive days in December. The 10 QSOs could all be on the same day.

Endorsements

- a) At least one QSO per day for any 10 consecutive days in December.
- b) QRP (5W or less), QRPp (1W or less).
- c) Straight key, bug, or cootie.

Options

- 1. Try for multiple categories.
- 2. Try for multiples: ie. 20 or 30 consecutive days, one QSO per day.

FDU will issue a certificate for those achieving the award.

Competitive form

To add extra fun, we are adding a competitive component to this activity. Separate to the above Award criteria, calculate your score as follows -

1 point per QSO at >5W

2 points per QSO at QRP

3 points per QSO at QRPp

The top 3 place-getters will receive an FDU Coffee cup with their callsign.

Submit your log in electronic format by 7 January 2025. A photo of your paper log, excel or other format is fine. Queries and logs to Chris vk3qb using his email address on qrz.com. The award is open to all VK and ZL ops. You do not have to be a FDU member.
