Don accorded a Vote of thanks to Geoff for stepping in to the ND role for the past 12 months.

Caravel report – making progress with the recommendations from this report

NZSAR survey for volunteer organizations – Don to circulate to Council, calls for action and

to grow volunteers as self governing bodies offering considerable funds for this to happen. LandSAR – paying for plans, SLA with LANDSAR to take over whole channel plan.

LandSAR

will pay for this service to be undertaken by AREC.

NZSAR – funding reviewed 3 yearly. Next 3 year plan and funding to be put by July 2019. No increase in the past 3 years. Considerable funding is available which is a benefit for NZART with the AREC falling under the umbrella of the parent branch.

AREC membership is conditional on being an NZART membership.

IARU R 3 amateur satellite request for support from NZART

ZL2JPM felt that this does not meet criteria, and Auckland university is using amateur radio for the purpose of launching a satellite with no benefit to NZART.

ZL2JPM believes this is an opportunity to create policy around such an event in the future.

Youth is big focus, with a donation from R3 for our youth to attend camp in Bulgaria.

Need to Invest wisely in protecting assets, i.e. spectrum.

In depth collaboration with R 1 in wireless transfer

Change in the way of doing things, we need to be proactive in making change. ZL2TLL reported that R3 is meeting quarterly times per year via Skype, with only one face to face meeting required.

Benchmark of R3 versus 1 & 2, they have more economic magnitude, however Australia and NZ need to start thinking about protection from intrusions. Member societies need to approach Spectrum Management to protect spectrum.
