From HQ...

Last issue, I mentioned that NZART had been contacted by a member of the French Amateur Radio community about participating in an event recognizing the end of WWII. While Council acknowledges public opinion about this event, they wish to make it very clear that NZART, as an association and community, does not support war in any form. NZART will not take part in the organization of this event, however, Council acknowledges it to be a way to recognize the end of the war and serve as a form of remembrance. Therefore they have approved the issue of the special event call sign ZL80MAY for a three month period. If anyone is interested in becoming the liaison between France and New Zealand, and act as trustee for this call sign, please contact HQ.

NZART remains neutral regarding participation extending beyond nations part of the Allied forces.

Development for the new NZART website is progressing well!

We are working with the developers to ensure a member's login and area. We hope to make this available in the new year. It will allow members to access past and current issues of Break-In, along with other changes that will make the site more user friendly!

BNZ has recently sent out notification of a new service they will be implementing to allow payees further security when making payments. Please read the full notification posted in this issue.

CHANGES TO MAKING ONLINE PAYMENTS

As some of you may already be aware, the New Zealand banking industry will be implementing a new system designed to alleviate risk of sending payments to the incorrect account and being scammed.

The new service automatically checks the account name and number while making payment to verify who's being paid, and ensure it is going to the correct place.

As such, this will alter the way payments are made to NZART and other services.

When making payment, you will see one of the four following results -

typo or isn't the exact name of

the account owner.



or it might not be the account

you mean to pay.

Either the payee's bank doesn't provide a checking service, or the account might be incorrect, closed, or unable to accept payments.

In order to verify you are correctly making payment to NZART via the new service, it's important you use the following details when making payment.

Payee name - NEW ZEALAND ASSOCIATION OF RADIO TRANSMITTERS INCO

Account number - 02-0772-0209760-00

account.

We have been advised by BNZ that 'NZART' should also work.

CQWW CW is coming up next weekend 23/24 Nov, one of the biggest international contests of the year and a great time to chase some DX. Also on that weekend is the WIA VHF/UHF Field Day. H – Night Contest

This year's "H Night" contest will be on **Sunday December 8th** and will follow the same rules as last year.

The contest marks amateurs return to air after WW2, which was on 8th December 1945. It is also the (NZ) anniversary of the 1941 Pearl Harbour attack, and commemorates all the amateurs who served, and especially those who gave their lives for our freedom during WW2.

There are $5 \times 1/2$ hour sessions, starting at **7.30PM NZDT** and concluding at 10PM. All stations are to use AM mode on 80 meters, points are awarded depending on the equipment used by the station you contact.

There is also an SWL section, with points awarded according to the type of receiver used.

The contest was reactivated a few years ago by Rob ZL2IW who is the coordinator. Rob will use the special call sign ZL6H for the evening. Extra points are awarded for contacts with ZL6H, and for vintage (valve) stations.

The rules are to be found on the NZART website under "contests"- look for <u>"H night</u> <u>contest"</u>. See also "SPAM"- the Society for the Preservation of Amplitude Modulationunder "activities". SKN honours the original amateur radio mode in an easy-going style. Operators send signal report, name, location, type of key, type of transmitter and power output. Stations are limited to 100W output power.

SKN is not a contest - but the operator who gets the most votes for the quality of their sending will win the Bruce Scahill Best Fist Award. This certificate honours Bruce ZL1BWG (SK), who was a dedicated supporter of SKN. Please email your nomination to ZL1NZ within one week following the event.

SKN uses the QSY Rule. Any station that calls CQ must QSY after making a contact.

SKN is open to all straight key operators, regardless of skill level or speed.
